

Privacy Policy

GENERAL

Your privacy is important to us. COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

When you use the University websites, including Gulf Coast College & Seminary, we require personally identifiable information such as your name, address, date of birth, email address, telephone number.

By giving us such information, you will need to consent to our using it in the manner described in this policy.

You may withdraw your consent at any time by emailing us at admin@scbu.edu . **We will return or destroy your personal information within five days of receipt of your withdrawal of consent.**

We and/or third parties from your browser as set out in this policy also record cookie information, pages you have requested and your IP address.

USE OF PERFORMANCE DATA

SMITH CHAPEL BIBLE UNIVERSITY (SCBU) will use performance data, including performance statistics, bug fixes and other similar data (“Performance Data”) uploaded to our Websites or acquired through our hosting vendor. SCBU may use such Performance Data in any way, including, but not limited to, using, editing, altering, reproducing, publishing and/or distributing the Performance Data for any purpose, commercial or otherwise, when such stripped of all personally identifiable information.

USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION,

DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We will not disclose your personal information to any third party unless you have consented to such disclosure or where we are required to do so by law. Should you breach our terms and conditions or terms of use or if we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, we may disclose your information to a relevant authority. This may include exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction. Any disclosure of personal information will be strictly controlled and made fully in accordance with current U.S. law.

COOKIES

Cookies are small data files that a website you visit may save on your computer or hand held device that usually includes an anonymous unique identifier. Our Main Campus Websites and those of our eCampus may use cookies for user authentication, keeping track of your preferences, promotional campaigns, tracking our audience size and traffic patterns, and in certain other cases. We may include small graphic images in our email messages and newsletters to determine whether the messages viewing.
